Membership is open to attorneys representing any Illinois school district, or who have represented an Illinois school district within the previous two (2) years, or who have maintained membership in the ICSA for at least twenty (20) years regardless of whether they currently represent a school district. In addition, eligible for membership are attorneys employed by an Illinois education management association, the National School Attorneys Association, and the Illinois State Board of Education and attorneys representing public school districts in states that border Illinois.
